# Online registration available for Reunion 2017

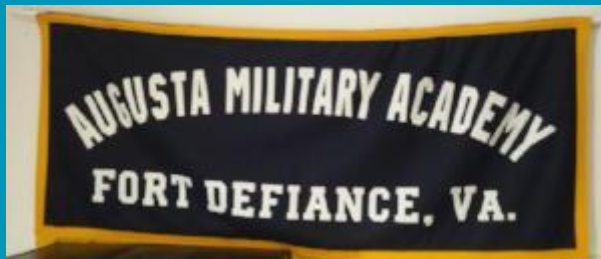
