**ADAMS, HAWES NETHERLANDS '39**

Army Second Lieutenant Adams was killed 14 June 1943 when his fighter crashed near Atar, Mauritania, Africa. He a member of the 14<sup>th</sup> Ferrying Group, US Army Air Corps.

Of Westfield, NJ, he was interred 2 February 1949 at Spring Hill Cemetery in Lynchburg, VA, the original family home.

At Augusta two years: Private, C Company and later in the Band Company; peep football, junior basketball, track, and Honor Roll.

He did not graduate; his younger brother, **Nathan L. Adams II**, was also at AMA, Class of '41.
