ALPHIN, DR. THOMAS HENRY '31 "Doc Thom"

Died 17 September 1995, at Oak Hill Health Care Center, Goshen, age 81.

Long time AMA Alumni Association Board member, farmer, and leader in the Goshen community. He was a native of Branchville, MD.

Alphin graduated from Augusta Military Academy, Washington and Lee University, and took his Master of Science and Medical Degree from the University of Virginia. He served as Chief Medical Examiner for State of Virginia; ran the Washington, DC, office of American Medical Association; was the Director of Medicaid in Alabama; and was a professor of medicine at University of Alabama.

Survived by his wife, Henrietta, to whom he was married for 56 years, and by two daughters, a son, a sister, and four grandchildren.
