ANDES, JAMES MICHAEL '36

Died 19 September 1995, in Staunton, age 78. Born 18 February 1917 in Augusta County, Virginia, he was the son of Dewey Davidson and Mae Weaver Andes. His grandfather, Jake Andes, was the community blacksmith in Fort Defiance.

He was a veteran of World War II and the Korean War. Prior to his retirement in 1979, he was employed at American Safety Razor for twenty-four years. He was a charter member of the Bethany Presbyterian Church and he had served as a Deacon, Elder, and Trustee.

Survived by wife, Elizabeth, a daughter, a sister, and three grandchildren. Burial was in Oak Lawn Memory Gardens, Staunton.
