AUSTIN, DENNIS URBAN JR. '46

Dennis Urban Austin Jr. died at his home on 30 August 2001 after a long illness. He was a son of Dennis U. Austin, Sr., former treasurer of Botetourt County, and the late Mrs. Dennis U. Austin, Sr.
