BACH, STANLEY M. '30

LTC Stanley M. Bach died on 17 February 1998, age 89, at Lexington, KY.

Played football and baseball at Augusta and the University of Kentucky where he graduated in 1934; halfback on the Wildcats 1932 team that defeated Alabama. While at AMA, Bach was captain of the football, basketball, baseball, and track teams.

Colonel Bach was a career Army officer. He served with 1st Infantry Division during World War II in the Normandy invasion and at the Battle of Remagen Bridge.

Survived by a daughter, Mrs. Ollie James Cockrell, and a son, Miles Edward Bach, both of Lexington. Preceded in death by his wife, Tommie Carr Bach, and a son, William Bach.
