BOWERS, WILLIAM HARVEY `43

Died 22 September 2011, at home in Sugar Grove, WV, with his wife of 61 years, Ruth (Nana), at his side. He was 86.

He was accepted at the University of Virginia Medical School but World War II intervened and he served as a radio/radar operator for the balance of the war. He returned to UVa and received his BA in psychology in 1949.

Bowers was a George Washington National Forest Fire Warden for 30 years; Sunday School Superintendent for 25 years; Past President, Pendleton County Farm Bureau; and Commissioner, West Virginia Department of Natural Resources. He was Instrumental in organizing the Treasure Mountain Festival, and he served 26 years on the board of directors of Rockingham Milling in Harrisonburg.

Survived by his sons, **Harvey Bowers Jr. `69**, of Wasilla, AK, and Jeffrey of Sugar Grove; a brother, John Roy Bowers of Sugar Grove; and two grandchildren.
