



## Remembering our brothers who have passed from this life

### **BRADLEY, CLAUDE POWELL JR. '43**

Sergeant Bradley, of Culpeper, VA, was killed Christmas Day 1944 when the troopship *Leopoldville* was torpedoed in the English Channel. His body was never recovered.

He is memorialized on the "Wall of the Missing" at the American Cemetery in Normandy, France.
