**BRADLEY, ERNEST PHILIP '50**

Died 23 August 2013, at Monroe, NC He was 87.

Bradley was a World War II combat veteran who came to AMA after the war. He had participated in the D-Day invasion of France in 1944, 70 years ago. Fifteen years after that event, he was the sole survivor of a Piedmont Airlines crash in 1959.

He worked as a labor union organizer and later as a dispute mediator for the Federal Mediation and Conciliation Service.

Survived by his wife, Rose (Zella); a son, Brad, from Monroe, NC; a stepson, Rick Toombs of Friendsville, TN; and three grandchildren.
