BYRD, FRANKLIN JAMES '34

First Lieutenant Byrd was killed 3 March 1943 when the plane he co-piloted crashed 25 miles from the city of Acarau, Brazil. He was a member of the South Atlantic Wing, Air Transport Command, Army Air Corps.

He was interred in Lorraine Park Cemetery, Baltimore, MD, his home town.
