COX, JUDGE WILLIAM JEROME '44 Jerry

Died 2 November 2012 at home in White Oak, VA. He was 81.

Judge Cox spent one year at Augusta, then returned to James Monroe High School in Fredericksburg. His Junior year was at Woodberry Forest School, and then he graduated from James Monroe.

He attended Randolph-Macon College for one and one-half years before being drafted into the Army. After his discharge he enrolled in the University of Virginia where he took a BA degree in English and a law degree in 1958.

He practiced law in Fredericksburg for twenty years and was appointed judge of the Juvenile and Domestic Relations Court for the 15th District in 1969. Upon retiring in 1991, he was recognized by the Stafford County Social Services for his lifelong commitment to abused and neglected children.

He was active in the local mental health association, the March of Dimes, the Little Theater of Fredericksburg, Ellks, Kiwanis, and Jaycees.

He is survived by Carol, his wife of 45 years, a sister, eight children, sixteen grandchildren, and six great-grandchildren.
