Survived by his wife Margaret; sons **James E. Crass IV '55**, and Jeffrey Lee Crass; daughters Barbara Crass Ross and Betsy Crass; sister Evelyn Anderson; 6 grandchildren and 3 great grandchildren.

Crass was at Augusta seven years: Captain, Company C; Varsity Swimming, Intramural athletics; Cotillion Club, Easter Dance and Final Ball Leader.
