CRUMMETT, CHARLES MARION '44

Less than nine months after he left AMA, Crummett was killed in action. He died on 3 March 1945 in a crash landing in the Lingayen Gulf, Luzon, Philippines while returning from a combat mission over Japanese-held Formosa.

His body was not recovered. He is memorialized on the "Wall of the Missing" at the American Cemetery, Manila, The Philippines.

An 18-year-old Sergeant in the U S Army Air Corps, he was awarded his aerial gunner's wings 12 August 1944. He was a tail gunner on a B-24J in the 400th Bombardment Squadron, 90th Bombardment Group.

Crummett, of Stuarts Draft, VA, was at Augusta one year: Private in Headquarters Company, Boxing Team.
