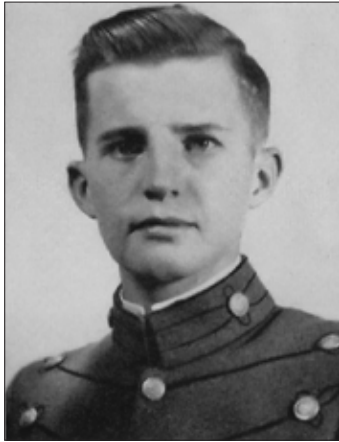

Edward Averill DeJarnette, 75, of Madison, died Saturday, September 20, 2003, in Orange.

Born October 29, 1927, in Orange County, he was a son of the late Elliott Hawes and Margaret Averill DeJarnette and husband of the late Harriet Deane DeJarnette.

Mr. DeJarnette was owner of DeJarnette Realty, a livestock and poultry farmer, an Army veteran of the Korean War and was a member of Madison County Planning Commission.

In addition to his parents and his wife, Mr. DeJarnette was also preceded in death by three brothers, Elliott H., Henry C. and Joseph S. DeJarnette.
