Henry Steiner Dunbar III , 80, of Richmond, died 22 October 2007.

Mr. Dunbar attended Augusta Military Academy and was a graduate of the Virginia Military Institute, class of 1948B. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army who served with the 2d Infantry Division in Korea and was decorated with a Purple Heart, Bronze Star and Silver Star.

As owner of the Candy Brokerage Firm, Dorset & Dunbar, he traveled extensively throughout Virginia and West Virginia. He was a passionate supporter of VMI, its football team, and the Keydet Club.
