ELLIS, CHARLES WILKERSON '42

Charles W. Ellis died 24 August 2007 at the Harrisonburg Health and Rehabilitation Center. He was 84.

A star T-formation quarterback at Harrisonburg High School and at the University of Virginia, Ellis played baseball in the days of the Valley League and coached college and high school football. Charlie was widely known and was respected by all as a gentleman and a serious competitor.

Ellis was a star pitcher at AMA and in college. He was named UVA's Outstanding Athlete in 1943, 1944 and 1945. He coached at Marquette University and the University of Cincinnati and was head coach at Petersburg (VA) High School. He worked in sales for the Ohio Knife Company. He was twice married and twice divorced.
