5 April 1998, at Rockingham Memorial Hospital in Harrisonburg, age 79. He was a fifty-year member of the Elks and a lifetime member of the VFW.

He attended the College of William and Mary and was inducted into the William and Mary Football Hall of Fame. He played professional football for the old Brooklyn Dodgers football team in 1948. From 1949 until 1950, he coached the Bridgewater College football team.

He served in the Army in World War II and was awarded the Purple Heart with three Oak Leaf Clusters, the Silver Star, and a Presidential Unit Citation.

Survived by his wife, Betty Ann; two sons, Nick, Jr. and **James K. Forkovitch '68**; and two sisters, Diana DeVero of Lorrain, OH, and Dorothy Rowe, of McKeesport, PA.
