FORRER, THOMAS HERRING '40

27 October 1997 at home in Keswick, VA, age 77, of cancer.

Graduate of the University of Virginia School of Engineering. Research engineer with West Virginia Department of Highways until his retirement.

Served in the U.S. Army in the Pacific during World War II and took part in five amphibious campaigns. Member of General MacArthur's Honor Guard at the Japanese surrender on board the *USS Missouri* in Tokyo Bay, September 1945.

Survived by four daughters (two sets of twins), Kendrick Brown Forrer Acker, Sarah Deyerle Forrer Jones, Elizabeth Chipley Forrer Gordon and Mary Mitchell Forrer Bricker; and a son, **Tom Forrer Jr. '67**.
