GOTTLIEB, WALTER C. '41

Walter Gottlieb died of cancer 6 March 2007, in Squirrel Hill, Pittsburgh. He was 81.

His World War II service was in the US Navy aboard the *USS Halsey Powell*. He was a championship swimmer and attended AMA on a swimming scholarship.

Gottlieb was a founding member of the Parkway Jewish Center in Wilkins, PA. He was a traveling salesman, a job from which he never retired.

Survived by his wife, Jennia; sons, Dr. Daniel Gottlieb and Dr. Sidney Gottlieb, both of Atlanta; a daughter, Sharen Gottlieb Scherger of Deltona, FL; two stepsons, Julian and Howard Elding; five grandchildren and four stepgrandchildren.
