**HANSON, HOWARD LORD, faculty**

Howard Lord Hanson, 70, of 202 College Circle, Staunton, died Saturday 7 September 2002 at his residence.

Mr. Hanson had an undergraduate degree from Hampden-Sydney College and graduate degrees from both Colgate and the University of Virginia.

In the past, he was manager at the Gypsy Hill Swimming pool for the Staunton Fire Department and taught mathematics and English at Augusta Military Academy from 1955 to 1964 . He also coached Tiger and Junior basketball during this period.

He was choir director and organist for Second Presbyterian Church in Staunton, and once served in that capacity for Trinity Episcopal Church. He was a lifelong member of Central United Methodist Church, and also served on the Executive Committee for Valley Symphonic Concerts, Inc.

He was preceded in death by a brother, Charles W. Hanson. Surviving are his brothers, Benjamin Shaw Hanson, Jr. of Arlington, and John Robert Hanson of Staunton; and a number of nieces, nephews, and cousins.
