HARRISON, CHRISTOPHER NORRIS '43

Christopher Norris Harrison died 28 August 2007 in Chestertown, MD, after a long battle with lung cancer. He was a member of the Scabbard and Blade, the National Military Honor Society and a member of Delta Upsilon fraternity.

He served in the Army in World War II in Italy, Austria, and Germany and was an enlisted instructor at the University of Pennsylvania ROTC Department before being commissioned as a second lieutenant in 1948. He served two tours in Korea and was discharged in 1966 as a major. He worked with the US Department of the Interior for two years and served as a GS-13 with the Navy Manpower Validation Shore Survey Team in Philadelphia.

He was an instructor at Washington College for four years and for thirteen years owned a sign company. He trained as a member of the Community

Emergency Response Team, part of the Citizens Corps. He also worked and volunteered at Queen Anne's County High School since 1991.

Survived by his wife, Barbara, and five children, six grandchildren, two great grand-children and two step-great-grandchildren.
