### **HART, MAJOR EDWIN '76**

Died 4 June 1999, at his home in New Hope, VA, age 80. Faculty member, counselor and lacrosse coach at Augusta from 1965 to 1976.

Major Hart was a graduate of Hobart College in Geneva, NY. He served as a Marine officer in the Pacific in World War II, and he had a career in the New York City Police Department before coming to AMA.

After AMA, Hart returned to the law enforcement field as Director of the Central Shenandoah Criminal Justice Training Center where he helped implement Virginia's continuing education requirements for law enforcement officers.

He was preceded in death on 25 February 1998 by his wife of more than 50 years, Jean Reber Hart. He is survived by four sons, William Hart of Charlotte, NC; Stephen Hart of Waynesboro; and Thomas and Wiley Hart of New Hope; and five grand-children. (Thomas Edwin Hart is a 1965 graduate of AMA)
