### **HART, ROBERT SEYMOUR SR. '70**

Robert Seymour Hart, a long-time faculty member at Augusta, passed away 17 December 2004 at Springtime Health and Rehabilitation Center in Roanoke. He was 86.

Hart taught 9<sup>th</sup> grade English and French at AMA for eleven years (1942-50 and 1967-70). He also taught at public schools in Augusta County, Maryland and North Carolina. His son, **George Elliott Hart**, attended AMA in 1969.

During World War II, Hart was a cryptographic analyst for the US Army Signal Corps. He served as President of the Virginia Retired Teachers Association (1993-94) and was given the Master Teacher Award at Fort Defiance High School in 1983.

Hart is survived by his wife of 59 years, Clara Ambler Hart; five sons, Robert,

Jr. and Paul of Fincastle, VA; **George** of Troutville, VA; James of Glen Allen, VA; and John of Roanoke; two daughters, Suzanne Snead of Moneta, VA and Mary Clark of Mt. Solon, VA; a brother, Max of Richmond; two sisters, Billie Warren of Salemburg, NC and Dorothy Warren of Ellicott City, MD; nine grandchildren, Brian, Aaron and Christian Snead, Jason Hart, Lacy Hart, Dusty Hart, Andrew and Zack Stewart, and Mike Burnett.

A service for Hart was held at the Augusta Stone Church on 22 December with interment at Calvary United Methodist Church Cemetery in Stuarts Draft, VA.
