HODGES, COL JOHN H. '35

Died 23 January 2010 at age 91.

A graduate of the College of William and Mary, Hodges had a varied career. He worked as a Park Ranger in the Shenandoah National Park, participated in the D-Day invasion of France with the 111th Field Artillery Battalion, 29th Division. Later he had assignments in the US, Korea, London and Heidelberg where he was Deputy Provost Marshall.

He returned to his hometown as PMS&T at William and Mary, 1969-72. After retiring from the Army, he was Director of College Residences at W&M, a member of the Williamsburg City Council, and Mayor.

Survived by his wife of sixty-eight years, Lib Hodges; two sons; and two grandsons.
