HUNTSBERRY, JAMES WALTER '51

James Walter Huntsberry, 72, died on 10 October 2006 at the Winchester Medical Center.

Jim was born 27 December 1933 in Winchester, Virginia, the son of the late Edward Rhodes and Virginia Hollis O'Connor Huntsberry. He was educated at Augusta Military Academy in Fort Defiance and graduated from Bullis School in Silver Spring, MD. He went on to attend the University of Virginia until he enlisted in the United States Army.

From 1953 until 1955, Jim was stationed in France where he met and married Claude Genevieve Lage on 3 January 1955, in Nancy, France. After his discharge, he returned to Winchester where he worked in the family business, Huntsberry's Shoe Store.

In 1968, Jim and his wife Claude began a career in real estate and opened

Huntsberry Realty Co. in 1972 . Jim was a member of the Braddock Street United Methodist Church and of the Virginia Society of the Sons of the American Revolution. Jim was active in many civic organizations during his lifetime.

He is survived by his loving wife of 51 years, Claude G. Huntsberry; one son, James W. Huntsberry Jr. and his wife, Valerie, of Kirkland, WA; one daughter, Gina R. Bayes and her husband, Ronnie, of North Garden, VA; four grandchildren, Sara C. Huntsberry and Julie R. Huntsberry, of Seattle, WA, James W. Huntsberry III, of Bowling Green, KY, and Timothy N. Pleasants of Charlottesville, VA; two brothers, **Edward R. Huntsberry '44**, of McKinney, TX, and **C.
