KAUFFMAN, RAY WIEGAND '45

Died on 28 April 2014 at Gilchrist Hospice Center, Towson, MD. He was 88 and the owner of E. J. Codd Machine Shop in Baltimore.

Ray was drafted into the US Army eight weeks before he graduated, and because of his AMA experience he was made a drill instructor. He later served as a tank commander in The Philippines.

His company made parts for the Three Mile Island nuclear plant, constructed part of the Baltimore-Washington Airport Terminal, and had Bethlehem Steel, Domino Sugar, and Allied Chemical as major customers.

He is survived by his wife, three sons, and seven grandchildren.
