KERR, WILLIAM K. '40

William K. Kerr, of Nampa, ID, passed away 8 February 2006 at the age of 82 . He died peacefully at home after a courageous battle with pancreatic cancer.

Born 19 August 1923 in Pittsburgh, PA, Bill attended Augusta for two years, then volunteered for one summer with the Civilian Conservation Corps in New Mexico, and joined the Army in 1942. He served with the 2d Armored Division ("Hell on Wheels"), part of General Patton's Third Army.

After the war, he attended the University of Florence (Italy), where he met his first wife. The family lived in Pittsburgh until 1958 when they moved to Boise, ID. He was a collector and had a deep interest in all kinds of music. His working career, primarily in accounting, included Boise Cascade, the Veterans Administration, and the Boise School District.

Bill is survived by Darlene, his third wife, and numerous children, step-children, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, nieces and nephews.

At Augusta for two years, he was a private in A and B Companies.
