## Knically, Bernard Clyde, '40

MgySgt. USMC, Ret. Bernard Clyde Knically Jr., 80, of 21 Woodlee Rd., Staunton, died Friday (May 17, 2002) at Augusta Medical Center.

He was born June 18, 1921, in Rockingham County, a son of Bernard and Violet Philips Knically.

He attended school in Staunton and Augusta Military Academy. He enlisted in the Marine Corps in September 1942, and saw duty in World War II and the Korean Conflict.

He retired after 22 years and returned to Augusta County. He was appointed as Chief Clerk of the Juvenile and Domestic Relations Court for Staunton, Augusta County and Waynesboro. He retired from the Court in 1985.

He was preceded in death by his parents and sister Rosebud Crotts.

Surviving are his wife of 58 years, Evelyn Riley Knically; his daughter, Judith Thomas Hermanson and her husband Rody of Churchville; his son, B.C. Knically III of Roanoke; grandsons, Brian Hermanson and his wife Kim, Justin and Jonathan Knically, all of Roanoke; granddaughter, Tracy Hermanson Burford and her husband Tim of Churchville; three great grandchildren; three brothers, Carroll Knically of Glasgow, Ky., Larry Knically of Harrisonburg, and Vic Knically of Augusta County; and a number of nieces and nephews.
