19 March 2004, at home in Suffolk, VA, age 76.

Drafted into the Army when he graduated from AMA, he was released in 1946 and enrolled at Virginia Tech. He graduated in 1950 with a degree in agricultural economics. He also received an ROTC commission and served four years during the Korean War. Employed by Esso (Standard Oil) and later was a commissioned agent for Esso. Owner of Suffolk Oil Company until his retirement in 1992. He and his son, Ted, acquired the Sting Ray Restaurant on the Eastern Shore in 2001.

Throughout his life, he was a very actively involved in the Suffolk Community and numerous organizations. He enjoyed fishing, tennis, woodworking, and fine cuisine.
