### **LOWE, CAPTAIN JULIAN ROBBINS '60**

Died 13 January 2007, 64, at home in Abingdon, Va. Graduate of the University of North Carolina.

Entered the U. S. Navy January 1965. Stationed aboard the *USS Frigate Bird*. After flight training, he flew primarily the Phantom and the F-14 Tomcat. Served in several East Coast fighter squadrons and training squadrons in Mississippi and Texas. During his career, he amassed over 5,000 flight hours and over 800 carrier landings aboard a dozen aircraft carriers.

Lowe had a tour as ship navigator aboard the *USS Carl Vinson* (CVN-70) and head of Nuclear Aircraft Carrier Acquisition on the OPNAV staff at the Pentagon. Commanding officer of Training Squadron 22 and the 1155 Caloosahatchee (AO-98). Last tour was on the staff at CINCLANTFLT in Norfolk. Received the Legion of Merit, Meritorious Service Medal and the Navy Achievement Medal.

Survived by his wife, Suzanne K. Lowe, and two sons, Andrew and Stephen, all residing in Abingdon. A full military honors service were held in Arlington National Cemetery.
