LYNE, HIRAM OLIVER JR. '34

Hiram Oliver Lyne Jr., 96, of Harrisonburg, VA, formerly of Orange, died 9 January 2004 at the Sunnyside Presbyterian Retirement Community in Harrisonburg from multiple complications following emergency surgery. He and his wife had only recently moved to Sunnyside from "Sage Hill" in Orange.

Born 9 July 1913 at "Willow Grove" in Orange, he was the youngest of eight children of Hiram Oliver and Mary Peachy Sizer Lyne. He attended Christchurch School in Christchurch, VA, and Augusta Military Academy in Ft. Defiance, VA.

Mr. Lyne was deferred from military service in WWII, serving in a critical industrial segment of the E. I. DuPont Company. He retired from the company in 1978 with 38 years of service.

Mr. Lyne is survived by his wife of more than 62 years, Florence Hope Sanford Lyne, of Harrisonburg; one son, Wickliffe S. Lyne, of Midlothian, VA; three grandsons, Dr. H. O. Lyne IV, Dr. Taylor Dillon Lyne, and Wickliffe S. Lyne Jr., all of Richmond; and an older brother, William H. Lyne, of Culpeper.
