MACEY, JOHN IRELAND '33

Army 1st Lieutenant Macey was killed in a motor vehicle accident 14 July 1944 near Grosseto, Italy. He was a member of the 337th Infantry Regiment, 85th Infantry Division. At the time of his death, Lieutenant Macey was S2 (Intelligence officer) for the 1st Battalion, 337th Infantry Regiment. Interred in US Military Cemetery Follonica, Florence, Italy.

Macey, from Paris, KY, attended Augusta for three years. First year: Private "A" Company, Minnow Athletics, YMCA, Company Basketball. Second year: Corporal "D" Company, Varsity Boxing Squad, Company Basketball, YMCA, *Recall* Staff, *Bayonet* Staff, Fresh Air. Third year: Platoon Sergeant "B" Company, Cotillion Club, Literary Editor *Recall*, Manager Swimming Team, Company Basketball, Assistant Leader of Thanksgiving Hops, Fresh Air, Honor Committee, Final Ball Committee.
