MAHONE, COLONEL WORTHINGTON MANSON '42

Died 12 June 2012 at Melbourne, FL, aged 88 years.

Mahone entered the Army soon after his graduation from AMA. He was commissioned in 1944 and served with the 96th Infantry Division in the Pacific during the Okinawa Campaign. His 31 years of military service concluded when he was Deputy Chief of Staff for Experimentation at Fort Ord, CA.

He commanded the 164th Combat Aviation Group in Viet-Nam. A rated pilot in both the Army and USAF, he was qualified in many types of fixed and rotary wing aircraft. He was a graduate of the Industrial College of the Armed Forces at Fort McNair and of the Army Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth. Since retiring from the Army in 1974, he was an architectural designer in California and Texas

Colonel Mahone was married to Mina Ayers Matthews for 58 years prior to her death in 2006. He is survived by his wife, Jean Sinko Mahone, and several children and grandchildren.
