### **MAROZZA, JOHN F. '49**

Died 9 May 1999, complications from diabetes, at Anne Arundel Medical Center, Annapolis, MD, age 69. A thoroughbred breeder and the founder and owner of T.L.C. Horse Transport and Windsor Hills Horse Farm.

Served in Army National Guard; called to active duty and served in Korea during Korean War.

Attended Christopher Newport College, worked at Newport News Shipbuilding and Drydock Company. Joined Baltimore Police Department upon discharge where he served for 21 years, retiring because of injuries in the line of duty. Worked as a detective, Greyhound bus driver, and highway demolitions worker; coached football and fencing.

Survived by his wife, Theresa, and three sons, Michael, Mark and David.

At AMA four years: Staff Sergeant in Headquarters Company; fencing team; member of the 1948 Championship Football Team, winning the Orchid Bowl 55-6 over a Missouri team that had won 21 straight games.
