### **MCCUNE, JOHN GARARD JR. '39**

Died 20 July 2001, at home in Windcrest, TX. He was born 17 September 1921 in Columbus, OH.

He was graduated from Augusta Military Academy in Fort Defiance, VA, in 1939. He then entered Dennison University, Granville, OH, where he was a member of Phi Delta Theta and Phi Beta Kappa fraternities.

He joined the US Army Air Corps in 1942 and served as a pilot during World War II. Part of his pilot training was at Eagle Pass, Texas, where he met and married his wife in 1944.

After the war he returned to Columbus, OH, and was graduated from Ohio State University Law School in 1950. He practiced law in Columbus until his retirement in 1985. He then moved to Windcrest, TX. He was an avid fly fisherman and an excellent golfer. He had two holes in one and shot his age several times in his last few years.

Survived by his wife of 57 years, Margaret "Peggy" Seymour McCune; two daughters, Carol M. Link of Titusville, FL, and Nancy E. Moore of Windcrest; a son,
