MICHAUX, ARTHUR F. '37

Arthur F. Michaux, 79, died 3 July 1997. Born 1 February 1918, in Ford City, PA, Mr. Michaux was a son of the late Fortune A. and Marguerite Masse Michaux and the widower of Louise Cannon Michaux. Mr. Michaux was a graduate of Ford City High School where he was a standout athlete in football, baseball, and basketball. He attended Augusta Military Academy, and George Washington University, Washington, DC, on athletic scholarships.

In 1991 he was inducted into the Armstrong County Sports Hall of Fame for outstanding contributions in basketball. He retired from PPG Industries, Meadville, in 1983 with more than 40 Years of service. He was a World War II Army veteran. He was a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church, Carlisle, and the Elks Lodge, Carlisle.

Surviving are two daughters, Mary M. Coffman of Carlisle and Elizabeth A. Michael of Reston, VA; a brother, Joseph E. of Pittsburgh; a sister, Evelyn Kropiak of Kittanning; seven grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
