Died 14 May 2001, in Boston, age 97.

Painter and illustrator. A combat artist in World War II, he spent two years in Vietnam during that war. His portraits of war and peace have been widely displayed at galleries and WW II museums, at the Smithsonian, and at the Franklin Roosevelt Library in Hyde Park, NY.

Born in Romania, he came to New York City at an early age. He studied at the Art Students League and later taught at Pratt Institute. He had no survivors.
