MORRIS, DR. JOHN NELSON '49

25 November 1997, at home in Pittsboro, NC, of pancreatic cancer.

First Captain at AMA, 1948-49. Graduated from Hamilton College, NY, then served as an officer in the Marine Corps before taking his doctorate in English at Columbia in 1964.

In 1996, he retired from Washington University in St. Louis where he had taught English for almost 30 years. He returned home to North Carolina where he served as a fellow of the National Humanities Center in Research Triangle, NC. A published poet and Guggenheim Fellow, John was working on his memoir at the time of his death.

Survived by his wife, Anne, and three children.

John attended Augusta for five years: Captain of Company A, First Captain, and Commander of Roller Rifles; *Bayonet* Staff, Ciceronian Literary Society, Honor Committee, Honor Roll.
