MORRISON, FRANK J. '40

Died 11 October 2002, in Chicago Heights, IL.

Served with the US Army 105th Infantry Division in World War II; invaded France on D-Day, 1944. He was awarded two Silver Stars and three Bronze Stars.

A Chicago City Policeman, he was awarded the Blue Star for bravery in the Gun Bomb Siege of 15 April 1969. He was also the first policeman on the scene of Our Lady of the Angels school fire in 1957. After retirement, he was head of security at Bally Manufacturing Company.

Survived by his wife, Georgiene; a daughter, Kathy Mariano; three grandchildren; and two great-grandchildren.
