PAYNE, FRANCIS W. '36

Died 22 February 2000, in Waukesha, WI.

A commercial artist and illustrator, Payne ran a successful business on Michigan Avenue in Chicago for 40 years.

Lieutenant and parachute unit commander in World War II, jumped into Sicily in 1943. He earned a second campaign star later in Italy. His unit was awarded a Distinguished Unit Citation and Frank wore a Combat Infantry Badge. He served in Italy until 17 January 1945 and was released from active duty in January 1946 with four years service.

At Augusta four years: South Atlantic Boxing Champion; captain, boxing team; track team; Honor Committee; Monogram Club; Cotillion Club Vice President; Lieutenant in B Company.

Survived by his wife of 57 years, Lillian.
