POOLE, ALAN LEO '67

Alan Poole died of a pulmonary embolism on 16 August 2006 in a Minot, ND, hospital. He was 58.

Alan was born in Cleveland, OH, on 8 August 1948, the son of Leo and Rita Raszkievicz Poole. He was raised in the area and attended a local grade school, before attending Augusta, which he entered at the age of thirteen. He graduated from the AMA in 1967.

He enlisted into the United States Air Force on 27 February 1968. He proudly served his country during the Vietnam War. He was stationed at the Minot AFB, ND, and at Hickam AFB, HI. He was honorably discharged on 25 February 1972. Alan was married to Carol Grenstiener in 1969. Together they had a son, Alan, Jr. They were later divorced.

He had worked for Lands Ambulance and Cenex for a short time, before starting his employment with the City of Minot Fire Department on 6 December 1976. He retired from the city in June of 2006 after almost 30 years of service. He was a member of the International Association of Firefighters Local 1157.

In 1988, he married Sandra Lochthowe-Schindler in Minot, where they continued to make their home. He had also worked part time for the Community Ambulance Service for several years, and then Taxi-9000.

He was an avid hobby enthusiast who enjoyed building model railroads and radio controlled airplanes. Alan enjoyed his return trips to the Augusta Military Academy for reunions where he was able to see his many classmates and friends, and also enjoyed taking vacations with his family and friends.

Surviving family includes: wife, Sandra K. Poole, Minot; son, Alan L. Poole Jr., Salt Lake City; stepsons, Billy (Kristi) Schindler and their son, Tyler, and Bobby Schindler, all of Minot; and father, Leo W. Poole, Minot. Burial was in Rosehill Memorial Park, Minot.
