RHODES, JOHN RAHILY JR. '47

Rhodes was killed in Korea on 21 July 1953..

He was an Infantry 1st Lieutenant, and he was killed by a shell which struck just as he crawled into his tent. He was killed in the last week of the war, and his mother received notification of his death on the day after the armistice was signed.

Jim Lane '49 recalled having helped him celebrate his last night home at the Norfolk Yacht Club before Rhodes left for the Far East in September 1952. Rhodes was a graduate of Georgia Tech and a cousin of **Lew Mundin '53**, who has clippings of his death.
