ROBERTSON, CHARLES HENRY JR. '42

Charles Henry Robertson Jr. of 1436 Northwood Circle, died Monday evening 8 May 2000 at Lynchburg General Hospital. He is survived by his wife, Elizabeth Bowles Robertson.

Charles was born in Baltimore, MD, he was the son of the late Charles H. Robertson and Ida Alberta Watt. Charles was a graduate of the Augusta Military Academy and the College of Washington and Lee and was a member of Sigma Nu Fraternity. He served his country in the US Navy during World War II and the Korean War, was also a member of First Presbyterian Church, the Lynchburg Board of Realtors, Ducks Unlimited, and Trout Unlimited. Charles was elected to serve on the Robert E. Lee Soil and Water Conservation District of the Commonwealth of Virginia in which he served as chairman for many years until his death. He also represented the Sixth Congressional District of Virginia as a member of the Electoral College of Virginia in 1980.

Charles was employed by PET Milk in Abingdon for many years and was owner and principal broker for Dominion Land and Real Estate.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by three children, Catherine Robertson Monroe of Lynchburg, Charles Henry Robertson III of Afton, Elizabeth Robertson McCormack of Monroe. He was preceded in death by a son, Paul Stuart Robertson. He has three grandchildren, Jessica May Robertson-Berry of Midlothian, Mason Thomas Robertson of Afton and Sarah Elizabeth McCormack of Monroe.
