**ROSEN, GLOYD ELWOOD JR '51 "Woody"**

PFC Rosen of Staunton was killed in action in Korea on 7 October 1952. His unit, Company H, 3<sup>rd</sup> Battalion, 7<sup>th</sup> Marine Regiment, 1<sup>st</sup> Marine Division, was at "Outpost Detroit" when it was attacked and overrun. His body was never recovered and he was listed as "Missing in Action". Woody was nineteen years old.

PFC Rosen was awarded the Purple Heart with Gold Star, the Combat Action Ribbon, the Korean Service Medal, the United Nations Service Medal, the National Defense Service Medal, the Korean Presidential Unit Citation, and the Republic of Korea War Service Medal.

He was survived by his widow, Allie H. Rosen, of Staunton.
