SINCLAIR, JUDGE ARTHUR W. '33

Died 25 February 2011 at home in Manassas, aged 96.

Washington and Lee University and Georgetown University School of Law. Practiced law in his hometown, Manassas, entering his father's law firm. Joined the Army Judge Advocate General Corps in 1943.

Founding member of the Prince William County Bar Association. Town Attorney, Manassas. Became youngest Virginia Circuit Court Judge at age 35, being sworn into office by his father in 1950. Retired in 1980 as longest-serving judge in the State and served as a substitute judge until age 90.

Founding member. Evergreen Country Club. First President, Prince William County Historical Preservation Foundation. A Master Mason, he had been a member of the Masonic Lodge for 69 years.

Survived by his wife, Emily Peters Maroon Sinclair.
