### **SNOW, TERRY GRAHAM '58**

Terry Graham Snow, 67, died April 6, 2007, at The Carrington in Lynchburg.

When the AMA Alumni House/Museum was being renovated, Terry took the lead in lining up the contractor and had plans to move to Fort Defiance to help operate the facility when it opened. These plans ended when he suffered a massive stroke in October 1999. Terry never made it back to AMA, but he was awarded the AMA Alumni Medal in March, just before his death.

Terry was born in Lynchburg, on March 6, 1940, the son of the late Dorothy Virginia Moffatt Snow and the late St. Elmo Snow.

He attended Lynchburg City schools and the Augusta Military Academy. Terry was employed at Imperial Reading Corporation, Lynchburg Foundry Company and as an Independent Sales Representative for Electronic Design and Manufacturing.

Terry is survived by his stepfather, Donald B. Brah of Lynchburg; his half-brother, John Chadwick Brah (Lilla Howle), of Amherst County; three sons, Kevin Graham Snow (Claudia Krisa), of Radford, Colin Patrick Snow (Sabrina) of Murrells Inlet, S.C., and Christopher Scott Gall of Georgetown, S.C.; and a cousin, Anne Geldhart Thompson of Hythe, England. He is also survived by two step-children, SFC Jason W. Conner of Dahlonega, Ga. and Victoria Foreman Esposita (Joseph) of Bedford;

as well as several step-grandchildren.

Terry was a member of the Church of The Epiphany (Anglican) of Amherst, where he served as Lay Reader and Junior Warden until his stroke in 1999. Terry was a member of the Augusta Military Academy Alumni Board of Directors, and the Vestry of the Church of the Epiphany. Terry was a skilled amateur cabinet maker and he built several remarkable furniture items for his home.
