STEPHENSON, BOYD WILSON '42

Died 24 September 2013 at University of Virginia Hospital in Charlottesville, aged 91.

He was the grandfather of **Museum Director Crysta Stephenson**, brother of the late **Luke Stephenson '39**, and the nephew of **Janet Stephenson Roller**, the late widow of **Major General Charles S. Roller Jr.**

Boyd left AMA to join the Navy and was a gunner's mate on a supply ship off the coast of Japan when two atom bombs ended World War II. US supply ships were the favorite targets for the Japanese and Germans.

After the war he operated a cattle and sheep farm on his family's ancestral lands in Monterey where his children, grandchildren, and great-grandchildren spent their childhoods.

Survived by three sons; Boyd ("Steve") of Virginia and Arizona, and Frank and Thomas, both of Monterey; two daughters; Somers Fullerton of Lynchburg and Monterey; and Charlotte Shamrock of Monterey. In addition to Crysta, he is survived by five other grandchildren and five great-grandchildren.
