STONE, WILLIAM LARRY '36

Died 1 November 1944 in a hospital tent in Europe. Stone had been wounded on 7 October and was recovering when he contracted pneumonia. His military record is not available.

An Army nurse who had treated him visited the family after the war and said that his chest wound should not have been fatal. The wet and cold field conditions of the hospital brought on the pneumonia.

From Bland, VA, Stone attended Augusta for one year: Private "A" Company, Peep Football Team, Varsity Wrestling Squad.
