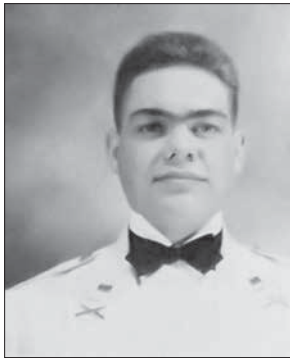

Arthur Francis "Art," 84, died Saturday, July 11, 2009, in Petersburg, W.Va. Born March 8, 1925, in Petersburg, son of Walter David Trenton and Edna (Hamstead) Trenton.

Predeceased by brothers, David, Dr. John, Robert and Paul. Mr. Trenton formerly owned and operated Trenton Electronics in Petersburg and was executive director of Potomac Highlands Support Services until his retirement in 2000.

He was a graduate of Augusta Military Academy, Fort Defiance, VA, and West Virginia University.

He was a Navy veteran of World War II and a life member of American Legion Post 78, Petersburg. He was a deacon and elder of the Presbyterian Church in Moorefield, WV; a 50-year member of Petersburg Masonic Lodge 145, F&AM; a 32nd degree Scottish Rite of Free Masons and a 50-year member of Petersburg Kiwanis Club.

Survived by his wife of 55 years, Ruth (Johnson) Trenton, whom he married July 17, 1954, in Johnstown. Also survived by son, James Arthur Trenton, Petersburg; daughter, Nancy (Trenton) Kascak, Oakton, Va.; and grandchildren, Erin Trenton and David Trenton, both of Maysville, W.Va.

A memorial service was held July 14 at Moorefield Presbyterian Church. Interment, Maple Hill Cemetery, Petersburg.
