**TUTWILER, WELDON FRANK '37**

Killed in an airplane crash 7 March 1944.

Captain Tutwiler was a C-47 pilot for the China National Air Corps, part of the "flying Burma Road" over the Himalayas from Calcutta, India, to Central China beginning in September of 1942. Based in India, they flew over areas held by Japanese and delivered medicines and supplies to Chinese forces. Tutwiler was a senior pilot and operated with an all-Chinese crew. Interred in Augusta Stone Church Cemetery, Fort Defiance, near his home in Weyers Cave.

Attended Augusta one year: Private, "C" Company.
